**INCIDENT:
Residential Burglary Investigation**

On Tuesday, May 4, 2010 at approximately 5:00pm, Greenburgh Police Officers responded to a residence on Sprain Valley Road in the Edgemont section of the township to investigate a past burglary. The preliminary investigation revealed that the homeowner had left their residence at approximately 11:30am and returned home around 4:45pm.

The homeowner observed that the front storm door and entry door were open. Once inside the residence the homeowner observed that the rear kitchen door was open and a window pane to the door smashed. It is believed the suspect(s) gained entry through the rear kitchen door and proceeded to ransack the upstairs master bedroom. The suspect(s) fled with several items of value.

A canvass of the neighborhood by Patrol Officers and Detectives was conducted. The Police are seeking the public's assistance in this case and would ask anyone with information to contact the Greenburgh Police Department at (914) 682-5300. All calls will be kept confidential.

The Greenburgh Police Department is also urging the public to report any suspicious activity they may observe to this agency either by calling E911 in the case of an emergency, or the above listed main phone number.
