## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EDGEMONT COMMUNITY COUNCIL

April 29, 2009

The Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Edgemont Community Council, Inc. was held at the Greenville School April 29, 2009. The following officers and directors were present: Bob Bernstein, Michelle McNally, John Blakley, Madelon O'Shea, Lisa Wexler.

Mr. Robert Bernstein, President, acted as Chairman of the meeting, Michelle McNally took minutes. Mr. Bernstein called the meeting to order at 8:15 P.M. 85 people signed the attendance roster.

Motion Charles McNally, second Madelon O'Shea, approved unanimously to accept the minutes of 4/30/08 as submitted and to waive a formal reading. Copies of the minutes are available at the sign in table.

**Treasurer's Report** by Michelle McNally: The ECC ended the year in a positive cash position. Total Assets as of 4/29/09 were \$5,898.58. Printing and mailing of ECC letters and SBNC letters make up the bulk of the annual expenses.

**President's Report:** Bob thanked everyone for coming this evening and for their support of the ECC. He gave a capsule summary of some of the issues ECC addressed over the year, noted that membership in the ECC continues to grow and that more of our younger residents are getting involved.

Nominating Committee and Election of Officers and Directors: Motion Madelon O'Shea, second, David Stern, approved unanimously. Resolved to accept the slate of ECC Officers, Directors and SBNC representatives as it appeared in the April 2009 Newsletter.

**Guest Speaker and Special Award for Distinguished School and Community Service:** A Silver Bowl award was presented to Ms. Nancy L. Taddiken for her outstanding service to the Edgemont community. This is the first time in the history of its community service award that the ECC has chosen to honor a non-resident. Mr. Bernstein noted that Ms. Taddiken is "not only involved in all aspects of our schools, but you can see her at just about every Edgemont function." He added that Edgemont is richer because of Ms. Taddiken's involvement.
