The Edgemont Community Council, (“ECC”) is a community council of Edgemont civic associations that has been active since 1947. ECC is the only common forum representing the entire Edgemont community. ECC takes positions on zoning, planning, budget, traffic, school district and fire district issues that affect the Edgemont community.

ECC also operates the School Board Nominating Committee, providing an impartial chairperson and underwriting its costs. In addition, ECC annually presents the “Silver Box Award” to an Edgemont resident for longtime commitment and exemplary service to the community.

The Board of Directors includes members-at-large, elected by the general membership at the Annual Meeting, and the presidents of the local civic associations or their designees. ECC meets monthly, usually on the first Monday of the month in the Faculty Lounge of the high school. Members of the community are invited to attend these meetings.
